On February 19, 2015, the National Architectural Accrediting Board directors met to review the results of the Interim Progress Report (IPR) filed by Florida A&M University in November 2014. The Board agreed to accept the IPR as demonstrating that the program has made progress toward addressing deficiencies identified in the most recent Visiting Team Report (2012). However, the focused evaluation scheduled for 2015 stands. The scope of the Focused Evaluation, as outlined in the decision letter dated August 3, 2012 will be on the following not-met Conditions or Causes of Concern as identified in the 2012 *Visiting Team Report* (VTR).
